

Mathematics

Number and Place Value - Find 10 or 100 more or less than a number. Recognise the place value of digits in a three-digit number. Compare and order numbers up to 1000. Read and write numbers up to 1000.

Addition and Subtraction- Add and subtract 3-digit numbers using written methods of column addition and subtraction. Estimate the answer to a calculation and use inverse operations to check answers.

Multiplication and Division - Recall the 3, 4 and 8 times tables. Calculate multiplication and division of 2-digit and 1 digit numbers using mental and formal methods.

English

- Design our own passports- To recap on key skills of punctuation and grammar. For example capitals, full stops, commas, question marks and word types.
- Persuasive writing- To write a letter using fronted adverbials, descriptive adjectives and conjunctions to engage the reader
- Non-Chronological report- To make a leaflet about a chosen country. Use headings, sub-headings, commas in a list and paragraphs to organise writing.
- Narrative action and setting – Develop the organisation and description of setting, character and plot within stories.

Science

To identify and explain the function of different parts of a flowering plant including stigma, stamen, style, anther and filament.

To explore the part that pollination, seed formation and seed dispersal play in the life cycle of the flowering plants.

To investigate the ways which water is transported within a plant.

D&T / Art

We will learn sketching and shading techniques which will help us draw architectural buildings in Bath.

We will observe architectural features of John Wooden the Elder and Junior's work.

Multi-skills- To recognise and describe the short term effects of exercise on the body during different activities.

Gymnastics- consolidate and improve the quality of their actions, body shapes and balances, and their ability to link movements on the floor.
