

Mathematics

Measuring- Measure, compare, add and subtract the following units of measure: lengths (m/cm/mm); mass (kg/g) volume/capacity (l/ml).

Time- Estimate and read time with increasing accuracy to the nearest minute. Record and compare time in terms of seconds, minutes and hours. Use vocabulary such as o'clock, a.m./p.m.

Fractions- Recognise and show equivalent fractions with small denominators. Compare and order unit fractions and non-unit fractions with the same denominators. Add and subtract fractions.

Properties of shape- Identify right angles and recognise that two right angles make a half-turn. Identify horizontal, vertical perpendicular and parallel lines. Recognise and describe 3D shapes.

Science

Rocks- Describe, in simple terms, how fossils are formed when things that have lived are compressed within rock sediment for millions of years.

Plants- We will investigate how animals and plants are suited and adapt to their environment in different ways including leaf and root formation.

Religious Education

Islam- Understanding the religion of Islam focusing on Ramadan and Islamic Rituals and Symbolism.
